At 6:31 PM Chair Neyland called the meeting to order, noting that this emergency meeting is being convened pursuant to MGL C. 30A § 20(b) and further that this meeting is being conducted via Remote Participation, pursuant to the Current Executive Order.

The documents discussed herein have been included with the file copy of the agenda packet for the above referenced date and are hereby incorporated by reference.

Chair Neyland provided background as to why this emergency meeting was necessary and why the Board is rescheduling the Boxborough Annual Town Meeting to June 29, 2020. She also reviewed the Town's Bylaw posting requirements and the process that the constables undertake to complete this process. On Friday morning it was determined that the warrant had not been posted 14 days prior to Town Meeting. Town Counsel is recommending that the Town delay Town Meeting by one week so the Town is in compliance with posting requirements. The Board discussed this.

It was clarified that the general Emergency Declarations and Stay at Home Orders that were put in place the last few months does override the "rule of law" and does not excuse communities from specific legal obligations, such as this posting. Only a Boxborough specific order signed by the Governor would overrule this. There are many items that are dependent on Town Meeting votes that permits the town to function, of primary importance is the Annual Operating Budget. This proposed course of action is based on the advice of Town Counsel. Pursuant to the recommendation of Town Counsel, Member Markiewicz moved to reschedule Boxborough's Annual Town Meeting from June 22, 2020 until June 29, 2020. Seconded by Member Fowlks. **Approved: 5-0.** Roll Call: Fox "aye," Stemple "aye," Fowlks "aye," Markiewicz "aye," and Neyland "aye."

At 6:43 PM, Member Fowlks moved to adjourn. Seconded by Member Markiewicz. **Approved: 5-0.** Roll Call: Fox "aye," Stemple "aye," Fowlks "aye," Markiewicz "aye," and Neyland "aye."

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: VIABILITY OF CHANGING THE SITE FOR THE 2020 ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

DATE: JUNE 18, 2020

At the June 15th meeting of the Select Board, there was some discussion regarding to possibility of altering the location of the June 29th Town Meeting. There was a particular emphasis on hosting the event outdoors. Consideration had been given to initially hosting Town Meeting outdoors. The reasons the Town chose to host the event in the Parade Room at the Regency Hotel versus an outdoor venue include the following:

1. **Suitable Location:** The two spaces large enough to host Town Meeting in Boxborough are Flerra Field and the Boxborough Regency parking lot. Flerra Field is not handicap accessible, has no available bathroom facilities, other than a temporary outhouse with no water source for hygiene, and electricity would need to be provided by generators. There are also no paved parking lots or exterior lighting onsite. Regarding the Regency Hotel, extending power into the parking lot would also be challenging. Unlike other communities, the Town does not have access to a football field and even if we utilized the football field at the AB high school, there would be inadequate seating for our projected number of attendees.
2. **Weather:** If the meeting were held outside with residents sitting in chairs or in vehicles, weather is a variable which cannot be controlled and could pose material issues. For example, this upcoming weekend the weather forecast is for 90+ degrees and humid.
3. **Expense:** Kirby Dolak, the Director of Boxborough Cable Television has seen estimates for hosting, recording and broadcasting outdoor Town Meetings in the \$10,000 range. The Regency Hotel parking lot would require significant expenditures to set up platforms for the Moderator, Select Board and Finance Committee. Determining an adequate audio protocol would be problematic and we could not utilize projectors for presentations. There currently has been a high demand for audio-visual companies who host outdoor events such as graduations, town meetings and other large-scale events, finding AV providers with the equipment and availability to host such proceedings is becoming

increasingly challenging. If we wanted to provide a tent, this would cost another \$5,000 to \$10,000 to accommodate a group of our size.

Some parties asked how the Town of Acton is managing its Town Meeting taking place in the AB High School Field House and parking lot. In my conversation with John Mangiaratti, the Town Manager in Acton, John indicated that the logistical challenges of managing Town Meeting in an indoor and outdoor setting at the same time are significant. John is dedicating four members of his IT staff to work on the logistics for the split Town Meeting and he estimates the cost to set up for in essence two Town Meetings will be roughly \$30,000.

Other Items of note related to a change of venue:

4. **Posting issues:** If the Town were to change the location of Town Meeting, we would need to repost the new location with 14 days' notice to the public. Another option would be to utilize the Regency Hotel parking lot as an overflow "room" for the June 29th Town Meeting overseen by a Deputy Moderator. Issues with this plan include:
 - The ambient noise from Route 495.
 - Sunset is scheduled for 8:27 PM on June 29th which would lead to other issues related to communications among the public and the Deputy Moderator in the dark.
 - Mosquito season has also started and health officials are warning that Eastern Equine Encephalitis, or EEE, is likely to return to the region.

5. **State guidelines for hosting Town Meetings:** The current plan for Town Meeting follows the guidelines established by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health issued on June 11, 2020. The safety plan also was reviewed, updated and endorsed by the Boxborough Board of Health at their June 10th meeting. The measures we will be undertaking include:
 - All attendees are asked to wear masks including speakers at the microphones.
 - The number of warrant articles have been reduced with the objective of completing Town Meeting in one night.
 - The lines to check-in and speak to articles will incorporate social distancing.
 - Seating within Town Meeting will be set up in pairs. Couples will be allowed to sit next to one another but will be separated from other attendees by at least six feet.
 - Ushers will be assigned to direct attendees to and from their seats.

In our current circumstances, bringing together large numbers of people does include some risk. With the measures the Town will be undertaking, however, the Town's public safety team believes we are taking the necessary steps to ensure a safe and efficient Town Meeting.
